Mounting / Personalizing Tips

This continuing section will cover a discussion on mounting/positioning a LaZee Mouse unit OR how to "personalize" the appearance of it.

The topic for this issue is painting. LaZee Tek highly encourages personalizing its products by/for the consumer. Our case is made of ABS plastic which is very similar to the plastic used in model car or airplane kits. The toy dept in most department stores carry models and model paints that are available in a wide range of colors.

To paint your LaZee Mouse product follow these easy steps.

1. Disconnect unit from cables
2. Remove any Velcro from bottom of unit
3. Clean unit to remove any dirt or residues
4. Apply masking tape to cover the connector openings of the USB connector and 3.5mm jack
5. Apply masking tape over the product label/reset button
6. Apply masking tape over the model & serial label on bottom of unit
7. Spray unit as desired, avoid spraying directly into the feedback LED holes. LEDs are recessed ~1/4" and should remain uncovered if the end of case is sprayed from an angle
8. Remove masking tape after paint has dried, within 12 hours
9. Overspray can be removed from product label with a Q-tip & Isopropyl Alcohol

Operational Tips

This continuing section will provide users helpful information on using our products and/or other computer equipment.

One of the quickest and easiest methods for matching a new user's skills to a LaZee Mouse or any hardware mouse device is also one of the easiest to overlook. The Windows TM Mouse Settings menu under Start-Settings-Control Panel ! These menus control various functions of the unit and can provide options and alternatives to match the user's needs.

- Cursor (Pointer) Speed
- Double Click speed
- Click Lock for dragging without continuously holding the click active
- Reversing the left & right button functions
- Can disable the right button in some operating systems
- Adjusting the pointer appearance & size
- "snapping to" moving the cursor to a dialog box when it opens

These settings are such a basic part of the computer setups, they can easily be overlooked. We recommend in our Operating Instructions, to start a new user at the slowest cursor speed setting, and adjust it upward only after becoming proficient at that setting.
